Paperless Homework







As set out in our guidance back in July, we are introducing a 'paperless' system for homework.

Seesaw is a platform for empowering students to demonstrate and share their learning. Students will use the tools in the **Seesaw app** to create, reflect and demonstrate their learning.

There will be a more detailed letter early next week to explain how to access SeeSaw.

In the meantime, you should receive a text message asking you to give parental consent for the children to use SeeSaw. The text will direct you, via School Money, to an online page where you can give your consent. Many of you will have already used this to consent to school trips. We are not asking for a payment, simply that you give permission for your child to use SeeSaw.

If you do not receive a text it may be because you need to update your contact details or you are a new parent and haven't yet returned your 'Pink Form.' Please contact the school office if unsure.

Whilst it may take a little while to get everybody 'up and running' this is a fantastic opportunity to reduce the amount of paper and avoid children losing or forgetting the homework!
