Important Covid-19 updates for our school, community and region

Yesterday, Sefton LA wrote to all parents to set out new guidance in response to the increase in Covid-19 cases being reported in our area.

At the time of writing, further restrictions for Merseyside are expected to be announced – as nine of the ten areas with the highest infection rates are in the North West.

Thank you to everyone who has responded so quickly to wearing a face covering. If you have missed the guidance, the main points were:

- All adults to wear a face covering when visiting or entering the school premises
- Only one adult to enter the premises for drop off/pick up
- Arrive and leave promptly when dropping off/collecting your child – PLEASE DO NOT CONGREGATE

In line with the guidance, staff will also be wearing face coverings at hand-over times.

Thank you in advance for limiting the amount of time you are on site, ensuring your child waits with you, wearing a face covering and maintaining social distancing.

Home Learning using SeeSaw

To facilitate 'paperless' home learning, we are using SeeSaw and we are very keen to get started! If you haven't yet given consent for your child to use this (through School Money or verbally by phone) you won't have received the codes/letters. Teachers will be starting to communicate through SeeSaw from today, so please give your consent and follow the set up instructions ASAP!
