Thank you for your patience, understanding and support as we continue to work our way through the changing guidance around Covid-19. It has been a challenging time for everyone.

As we are now in 'Tier 3' and the number of cases continues to grow, affecting so many families, I have been asked by Sefton LA that you:

and remind you about the restrictions on young people mixing outside of their school setting as sleepovers and birthday parties are still going ahead inside homes or outside in groups larger than 6 people. Sefton Council have developed a set of FAQ's which explain some of the regulations, parents may be unsure about.
