

Although we won't all be in school together by then, there are several activities we would like to recommend. If your child is in school, their class teacher will be sharing the same activities on the day..

Activity 1

'The Masked Reader' – Who Is Behind The Mask?

Some of the FJS staff have had a lot of fun choosing their favourite children's book to read from behind a disguise! Their videos will be live on the school website on World Book Day, for you to crack! You will need to match the character to the teacher and for an extra challenge name the book they are reading!

Activity 2

Please support your child to choose a **favourite book character**. You might need to pick one that most people would know, or one the children have studied in school. Then create three or more clues to give to people in order for them to guess the identity of the character. These will be shared in class if your child is in school or in your child's Zoom meeting next week beginning 29/02/21.

Activity 3

Activity 4

Drop Everything And Read! World Book Day is centred on creating a love of reading, so the more you can read, the better! Books from home, school, YouTube, comic books, newspapers, magazines, even e-books and extracts which are available on:

<https://www.lovereadings4kids.co.uk/> - a fantastic place to find literature suitable for your child's age, and it's free to set up an account!

Ask your child to choose their favourite book/text that they've read that day and illustrate the **daffodil template** that is attached, to include: title/author's name/ a favourite scene from the book/ a summary of the text. The daffodils will be welcomed into school with the children when they return on March 8th to brighten up our school library and corridors as a welcoming display for the FJS community.

Activity 5

On the World Book Day website, there are lots of practical, fun activities, please choose some to complete that capture your interest.

Each year children across the country receive a £1 World Book Day voucher. These are valid until March 28th 2021 and are welcomed in bookstores eg Pritchards in Crosby Village alongside supermarkets such as Sainsburys and ASDA.

We are looking forward to World Book Day 2021 and cannot wait to see all your contributions on Seesaw.
