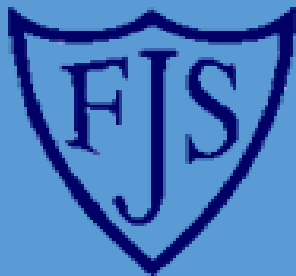

The latest data shows that 'Covid-19 cases are falling among almost every age group in England, apart from school children and their parents' generation.' You will be reassured to know that we do not currently have any positive cases at FJS – but nationally 'more than 10% of school children have been absent on any single day since schools reopened in September.' In conversation with Public Health England this week, they were pleased to see that our response to cases in school had helped to limit the spread. You may remember that we introduced stricter controls ahead of any guidance. For this reason, we have continued to keep each year group separate at lunchtime and we have not returned to whole school assemblies.

Playtime rotas have ensured that each year group has the playground/MUGA to themselves. We have been encouraging pupils to socialise and play together and with the arrival of new play equipment, we will be able to add new games shortly. Unfortunately, our fantastic play areas have not yet been fully refurbished (the wind and rain have taken their toll on the timber) but we do have plans to introduce new play leaders to encourage further activity.
