Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to offer an after school drama class for pupils in Years 5 by 'Limelight @ Liverpool' drama academy.

Limelight is a nurturing and safe environment to help both harness existing talent and support beginners who need to develop their confidence at a pace that is right for them. The academy gives young people expert teaching from a LAMDA endorsed teacher who has an enhanced DBS certificate and over 16 years' experience of teaching drama to young people and directing large scale productions.

Weekly sessions are aimed at both boys and girls and will focus on team building, vocal confidence and delivery, building stage presence and confidence in front of a small audience. Children will also be exploring their own creativity through imaginative role play and improvisation. Sessions will be fun and informal with lots of opportunities for working in small groups and learning valuable life skills through drama.

Sessions will cost £4.00 and will be held every Thursday after school at 3.30 p.m. Children must be collected from the main entrance at 4.15 p.m. The first session will be on **Thursday 30th September 2021** and the last on **Thursday 16th December 2021**. Session dates will be as follows:

December 2nd, 9th, 16th

It is an 11 week offer with limited places and will be offered on a first paid, first served basis.
